**NO NOVELTY ITEMS
HANDMADE ITEMS ONLY**

1. Craft vendors may participate in the Crafts on the Grounds for one or both days, for the same fee. You must indicate on registration form which days you will be participating.*
2. Vendors may pull alongside the craft area to unload vehicle/trailer if using the pre-arranged time. It must then be moved to the general parking area as soon as possible. Other arrangements will be made for tear down.
3. Vendors must submit registration forms and payment before applications will be processed. No spaces will be held for applicants until fee has been received.
4. Vendor is responsible for items at all times.
5. Tables, chairs, and pop up tent or canopy are to be provided by vendor. Displays, tents, tables, and chairs are to stay inside your designated area.
6. There is **NO** electricity available in the Crafts on the Grounds area.
7. Vendors are responsible for cleanup of their areas, upon tear down.
8. No smoking within Crafts on the Grounds area or anywhere on the festival grounds.
9. No walking inside the pathways and crowd for solicitation.
10. Banners may be hung up within and/or on your tent/tables.
11. Vendors are responsible for paying their own City of Washington sales tax.

The Vendor or his/her designee will hold the Washington Chamber of Commerce, its volunteers, John Bearce, John Bearce Companies, and the City of Washington harmless for any damages from injury or damage sustained to their employees, them, any products, merchandise, or personal item/items.

The Vendor or his/her designee are solely responsible for lost goods due to any cause including but not limited to simple loss, damage by water, fire, and act of God, theft, terrorism, or vandalism.

Organizers of the Good Neighbor Days Crafts on the Grounds reserve the right to refuse space to any individual, group or organization, which in their opinion is deemed improper, offensive, or questionable and is not in keeping with family oriented activity. If action by Vendor requires cancellation of space during Craft on the Grounds' hours, the exhibitor will be required to remove everything immediately upon notification and to vacate the premises with no refunds.

A set up time will be pre-arranged with you once your application has been accepted.
 - **Space is limited and will be assigned on a first come first serve basis.**
 - **Registration Deadline is Friday, April 28, 2017.**
 - **No refunds after May 12, 2017. No refunds due to inclement weather.**
